From 16-18 January 2017 we were recording tracks at Western Star Studios for our debut CD album, 'Rocket Powered'. We were really happy with the session and would like to thank Alan Wilson for his hard work and expertise.

We recorded 9 new songs (including one cover) and these will be added to the 6 tracks recorded in May 2016 to create a 15 track album. This was an experience we will never forget and we can't wait until it is released in Spring 2017. Watch this space for more info!
